

## VENUE

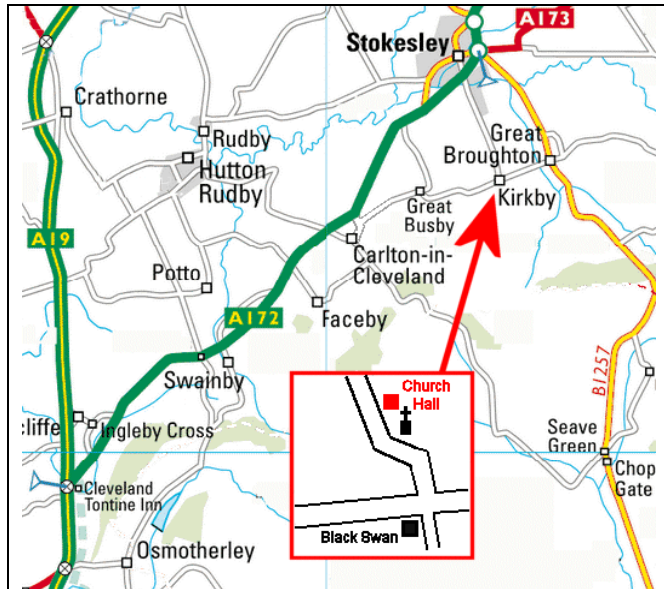
The Symposium will be held in St Augustine's Church Hall, Kirkby Lane, Kirkby-in-Cleveland. OS grid reference, NZ 538061, postcode TS9 7AQ. The hall is the 2<sup>nd</sup> building to the north side of the church.

Kirkby-in-Cleveland is located about 2 miles south of Stokesley. It is easily accessible, about 8 miles from the A19 dual carriageway.

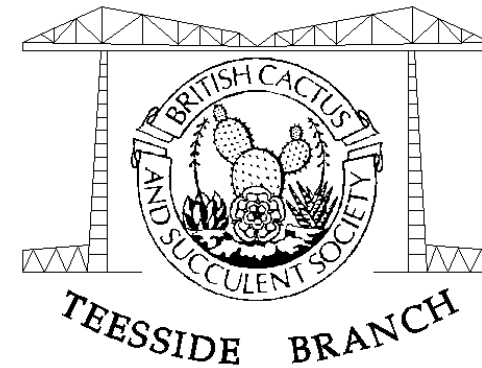
If approaching from the south, turn off the A19 onto the A172. After about 5.5 miles turn right (signed Carlton, Gt. Busby & Kirkby), then immediately left onto Busby lane (signed Gt. Busby, Kirkby and Broughton). At the crossroads in Kirkby-in-Cleveland, turn left and the church and hall are on your right.

If approaching from Stokesley, take Station Road (which becomes Kirkby Lane after the industrial estate). The hall is on the left.

Parking is available at the hall and in the village. Disabled access and facilities are provided.
